The Craven Muster Roll 1803

The threat of invasion by Napoleon made it necessary to prepare the whole of the active male population of the country for military training.

All men between the ages of 17 and 55 were entered in one of four classes.

- Class 1 unmarried, under 30 with no child living under 10 years of age.
- Class 2 unmarried, between 30 and 49 with no child living under 10 years of age.
- Class 3 married, between 17 and 29 with not more than two children living under the age of 10.
- Class 4 Those not entered in the above classes.

Some men such as judges, clergymen, Quakers, constables, peace officers, those already in military service and infirm persons were to be distinguished in the rolls because they were exempt from call up under this act. Volunteers were also to be distinguished.

Interestingly even though there were would be Quaker families in Rimington at this time, not one man has described himself as such. Nor does anyone describe themselves as a constable, bye law man, or peace officer.

Over 8000 men are listed on the original muster roll parchments that make up the roll. 103 were in Rimington and Middop.
