
1. Ings Beck and ridge (DK walk 1) Appproximately 2 miles



Start in the car parking place at the Downham end of the village, to the right of Bustards Farm **1.**Go over stile **2** into a large field.

Walk diagonally towards marker post in remains of the field boundary. Then carry on to the corner of field to the kissing gate 3. Turn left onto the concrete driveway and almost immediately to your right go over another stile 4 into a small field.

Cross the field diagonally to go over a stile **5** in the corner behind a fallen tree and then continue in the same direction up a slight slope to cross a further stile **6** in the far corner.

Once over the stile bear slightly to the 7 left to go downhill and then cross the footbridge over Ings Beck 7. It was near here that the Roman road from Ribchester to Ilkley crossed the beck. Carry on towards a wall 8 ahead with the beck on your right.





When very near to the wall you will almost be opposite a bridge **9** over Twiston Beck. Just before the wall turn to the **left** and walk with the wall and then fence on your right for approximately 700 metres. On the way you will soon pass the remains of a stile **10**.

Below you will see the spoil heap **11** from a barytes mine. All along the route there are excellent views to the north and northwest. Finally a gate will be reached with a stile **12**, 20 metres to the right of it. Go over the stile into the next field.





Go diagonally to the right to stile **13** in the far corner of the field. Go over this stile and immediately turn left to go down the footpath to bridge **14** over Ings Beck.







Carry on up a slight slope to stile 15 then on to 2 redundant V stiles 16 which can be passed to the left through a gap in the fence. There are holiday cottages on your right.

Then continue on to cross stile 17 (which can be muddy in wet weather) and then drop down to Rimington Lane at stile 18.

Turn to the left and after a short distance pass Rimington House 19 on the RHS. Picture **20** shows the Black Bull pub as it was before its conversion. A further short distance brings you to the starting point just beyond Bustards Farm.
