

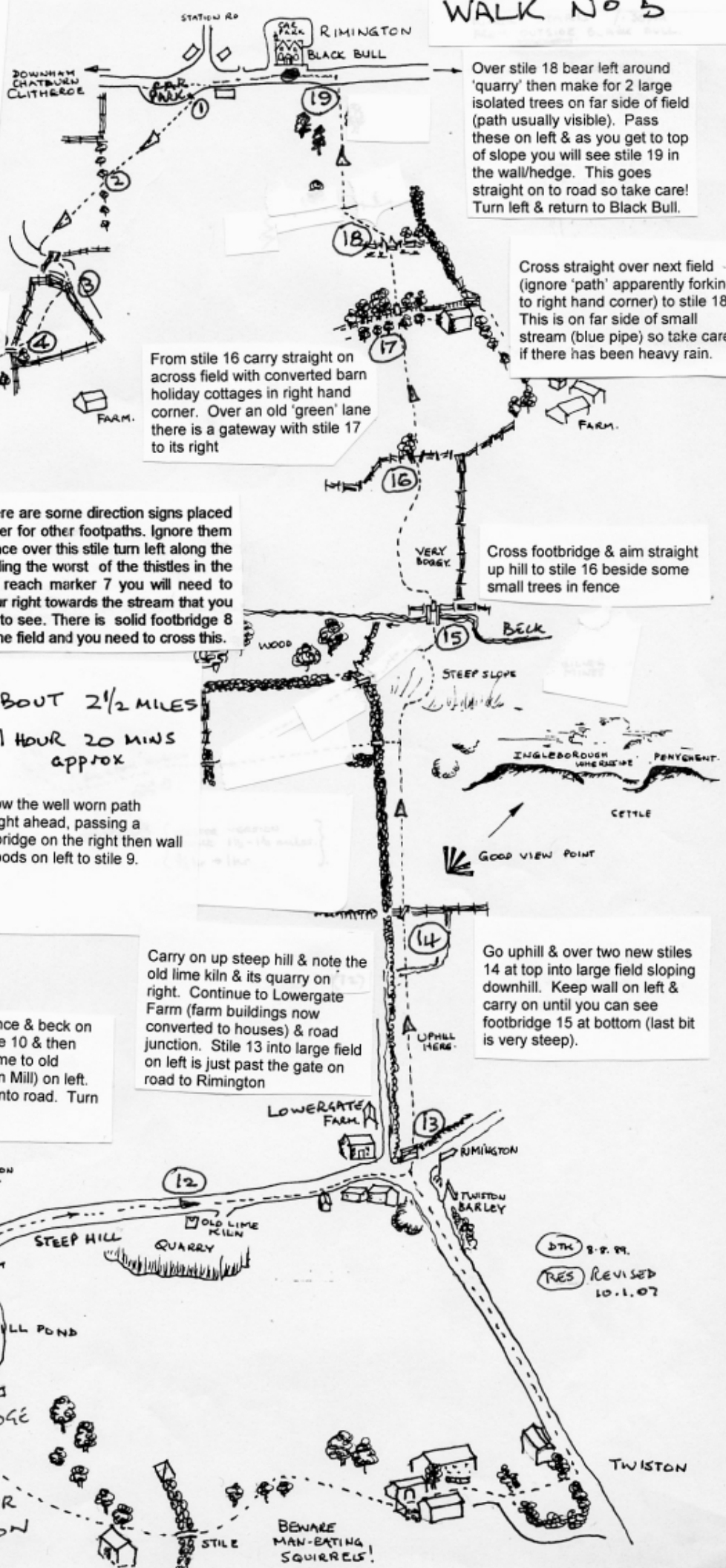
WALK NO 5

Enter the field over stile 1. To your right, in line with the end of Pendle Hill you will see a marker in a line of trees. Walk towards this marker.

At the marker 2 you will see below you and ahead of you the road that leads up to Stubbs Wood Farm. Descend to this concrete road. There is a gate across at the bottom which is nearly always open

Turn left for a short distance on this concrete road. You will pass a field gate into a small meadow, and close to it you will find stile 3. Climb over it into the meadow. There may be some caravans here.

Cross this meadow to stile 4, which is under the tree in the opposite corner of the field. From stile 4 you will see another post and marker 5 in the field, uphill and slightly to your left. Walk towards this marker. When you reach it you will be able to see stile 6 in the corner of the field. So far you have been walking in almost a straight line towards Pendle Hill.



Over stile 18 bear left around 'quarry' then make for 2 large isolated trees on far side of field (path usually visible). Pass these on left & as you get to top of slope you will see stile 19 in the wall/hedge. This goes straight on to road so take care! Turn left & return to Black Bull.

Cross straight over next field - (ignore 'path' apparently forking to right hand corner) to stile 18. This is on far side of small stream (blue pipe) so take care if there has been heavy rain.

From stile 16 carry straight on across field with converted barn holiday cottages in right hand corner. Over an old 'green' lane there is a gateway with stile 17 to its right

Cross footbridge & aim straight up hill to stile 16 beside some small trees in fence

Beside stile 6 there are some direction signs placed here by the farmer for other footpaths. Ignore them for this walk! Once over this stile turn left along the wire fence, avoiding the worst of the thistles in the field. When you reach marker 7 you will need to drop down to your right towards the stream that you will now be able to see. There is solid footbridge 8 in the corner of the field and you need to cross this.

ABOUT 2 1/2 MILES
1 HOUR 20 MINS approx

Follow the well worn path straight ahead, passing a footbridge on the right then wall & woods on left to stile 9.

Carry on up steep hill & note the old lime kiln & its quarry on right. Continue to Lowergate Farm (farm buildings now converted to houses) & road junction. Stile 13 into large field on left is just past the gate on road to Rimington

Go uphill & over two new stiles 14 at top into large field sloping downhill. Keep wall on left & carry on until you can see footbridge 15 at bottom (last bit is very steep).

Continue with fence & beck on right, through stile 10 & then gate until you come to old buildings (Twiston Mill) on left. Go over stile 11 into road. Turn left up the hill.

FROM STILE 11
If you want a longer walk: turn right & after 20 yards or so there is a gate on left. Cross the bridge then follow map.
